Today we will be sending home the NAPLAN results for Year 3 and Year 5. You may have heard over recent weeks some controversy regarding the results. As you may be aware, we are moving to a digital assessment from 2019. The problems arose because some schools trialled the the online version and it varied from the pen and paper version. The two are complex to compare. Our students participated in the pen and paper version. The results are overall very pleasing. In all areas (reading, writing, spelling, grammar and punctuation and numeracy) our school average was higher than the national average. Congratulations all. NAPLAN results should always be interpreted with care. The information contained in the report should be considered together with school-based assessments and reports. Please contact your child's teacher to gain the best insight to their educational progress.

As the weather is so unpredictable at the moment, children can wear either summer or winter uniform. By week 3 of next term, I expect that all children will be in their full summer uniform. Just a couple of reminders:

1. Joggers need to be black or mostly white with no coloured laces
2. Hair needs to be neat with no extreme cuts
3. Jewellery is to be kept to a minimum - watches are OK and sleepers or studs for the girls' earrings

Next Tuesday September 25, St Paul's will participate in our **Peer Review/Compliance Audit for 2018**. Peer Review has been approved by the NSW Education Standards Authority (NESA) for the registration period (2015-2019) and is unique to Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta (CEDP) in the current form and structure of implementation.

Peer Review must adhere and align to the compliance areas as specified by:

- the NESA Registration Systems and Member Non-government Schools (RANGS) Manual
- the NESA Assessment, Certification and Examination (ACE) Manual, ACE Manual
- CEDP requirements (including Religious Education)
- Focus 160 (literacy and numeracy).

Our Stage 3 teachers will present programs, assessment plans, scope and sequence and student work samples on English and Creative Arts.

Next Friday September 28, Jane Misek leaves for her **pilgrimage** to the Holy Land, Rome and Assisi. This is a once in a lifetime opportunity to experience the land where Jesus walked and lived during his time here on earth.
